Enrollment -15% of students are economically disadvantaged, 5% are minority, and 10% of students have diagnosed disability. A total of 405 students currently enrolled. Of the 405, 217 students are located on East campus, 187 on West campus. There are 36 students on IEPs. Enrollment for 2022-2023 opens January 1, 2022.
