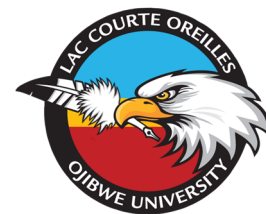

KNOW THE DETAILS

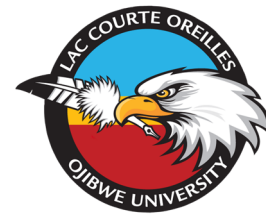
- Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe University scholarships are not cash awards
- Scholarships are deposited directly into student accounts
- Students will only be awarded one scholarship upon approval by Scholarship Committee.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Admission to Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe University (as a new, continuing, or re-enrolled student).
2. If a continuing or re-enrolled student, you must be in satisfactory academic progress status (2.0 GPA or better) at the time of application.
3. Must be registered for at least 6 credits and be a degree seeking student.
4. A FASFA must be completed and be submitted to Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe University for the corresponding academic year, including all requested verification requirements from the Financial Aid Office.
5. You must complete your Tribe's higher education scholarship application each year, if applicable.
6. Unofficial Transcript must be submitted with LCOOU Scholarship application.
7. The completed application must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office once each academic year no later than Census Day, see the academic calendar.
8. Upon receipt of a scholarship, submit a thank you note or letter to the Financial Aid Office to be shared with the donor.
